

SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS FROM REPORTS TO THE CANCELLED STEERING GROUP MEETING, 3 FEBRUARY 2009

The NuLeAF Steering Group meeting on 3 February had to be cancelled because of the snow and ice. However, the recommendations contained in reports to the meeting were agreed with the Chair, following opportunity for electronic feedback from those that would have attended.

The recommendations were as follows:

Item 4: Developing Strategies for Managing Low Level Wastes

That the Steering Group:

- 1 Endorse promotion of discussion of a 'hierarchy of siting preferences' for management facilities for nuclear industry LLW.
- 2 Encourage member authorities to participate in the seminars in May on draft LLW strategies.
- 3 Commend the case studies on LLW management to member authorities.

Item 5: Approaches to Community Funds

That the Steering Group endorse the draft Discussion Paper as a basis for further discussion with Government.

Item 6: NDA Strategy Review and Developments

That the Steering Group consider:

- 1 Attendance at the Strategy Review Group meeting on 23 March
- 2 Representation at the National Stakeholder Group on 17-18 June.

Item 7: Radioactive Waste Management and the Future of Nuclear Power

That the Steering Group endorse the proposed responses to (a) the discussion paper on the Funded Decommissioning Programme and (b) consultation on the application for justification of new nuclear build, as outlined in this report.

All the item topics above are covered in written reports to the Steering Group meeting on 28 April.
