

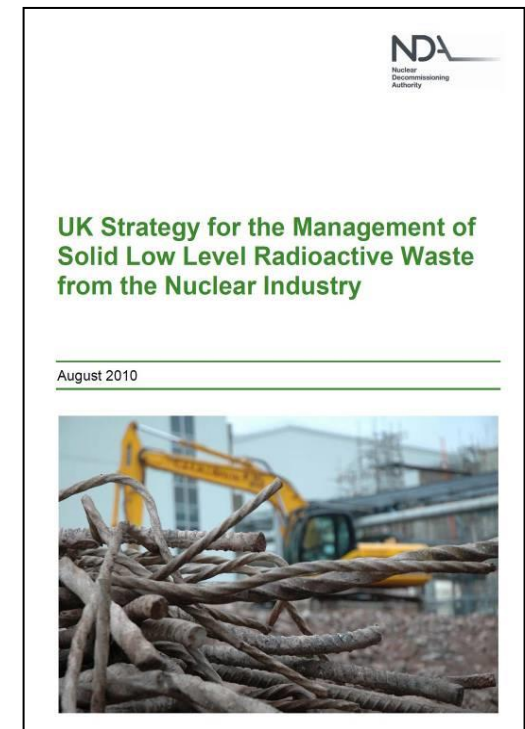

# UK Nuclear LLW Strategy Production

- **The UK Nuclear LLW Strategy was approved by Government in August 2010**
- **NDA has been tasked by Government to deliver the Strategy**
- **Key aims of the Strategy are:**
  - Requirement for a replacement LLW Repository eliminated
  - Ensure consistent application of the waste hierarchy
  - Public recognition of delivery of safe, high quality LLW management
  - Alternative disposal routes established;
  - Reliable waste forecasts
  - Revised permit and Safety case



# UK Nuclear LLW Strategy Review

---

- **Review the UK Solid LLW Strategy to ensure that:**
  - Fulfils the intent of Government Policy
  - Reflects the current maturity of the industry
  - Defines the direction of travel
  - Identifies where there are opportunities to mature the strategy to improve LLW management practice
  - Aligns with non-nuclear, NORM and developing Higher Activity Waste (HAW) Strategies
- **Assume that the three key strategic themes remain valid:**
  - Application of the Waste Hierarchy
  - Best use of existing LLW management assets
  - The need for new, fit for purpose waste management routes

- **Section by section reviews**
  - What is working well?
  - Threats
  - Opportunities
  - Issues
  - What needs to change to make this section fit for purpose for the next 10 years?
- **Strategic Environmental Assessment**

# High Level Output

---

- **No indication that the current strategy is failing/not heading in the right direction**
- **Make it clear that it is a UK strategy not NDA strategy**
- **Remove all actions & place any implementation activities in separate document**
- **Align with & reference to other waste strategies**
